Objectives:


Recognize characteristics of learners (students and/or adults) who would benefit from Paige Connect based on literacy needs, learning goals and learning environments.

Meet the Paige Connect

- 9 U-Shaped black optical sensors
- USB-A power cord
- Back of board has round hole for power cord
- Replaces the bottom of a traditional Braille Writer
- Board is durable, feels like metal
- Connects via Bluetooth



Connecting to Your Traditional Braille Writer









Transcribe in Real time










Learn Braille

Learning with Paige Braille


Learning activities

- Review Reinforcing activity for everything learned








Learn Braille with Us (Read)


Individual Support and Learning





Homework


- Offers individual practice based on concepts that need just a little extra practice.

Using Paige Connect
